We invite you to a talk on the STRI (Services Trade Restrictive Index) which is a tool used for mapping of global trends in services trade negotiations for economies across the globe intended to extensively benefit trade negotiators, policy makers and businesses engaged in services trade. The talk focusses on the WTO-WB STRI which has been developed by the World Bank and the World Trade Organization ('WTO'). The STRI creates a benchmark where countries can measure their policies relative to global best practices and assess the likely impact of any reform options based on the policy measures which restrict trade in services.
